- 4. We hosted Base Hospital continuing education on February 7, 2017.
- 5. Firefighter Friedenberg attended and completed a confined space rescue course at the Fry Fire District on February 6th-10th.
- 6. We hosted a S130/190 Basic Wildland Class on February 11th, 12th, 18th, and 19th.
- 7. Captain Garner, Captain Tingle, and Firefighter Friedenberg will be attending Wildland Fire and Incident Management Academy March 12-16 in Prescott.

Wildland:

1. We have had 3 additional Wildland assignments since the last meeting. The Noonan, Trail, and the FA Ash creek. We have a total of \$1,323.70 billed to the Arizona Department of Forestry and Fire Management.

Out of District Fires:

1. We currently have a balance of \$48,409.97 outstanding for 17 fires that occurred outside of the district boundaries since 2012. Of the out of district fires, nine incidents, with a total of \$ 19,714.96 are in collections. Total unpaid balance that is not in collections is \$ 28,695.01.

Emergency Medical Services:

February total billings to date are \$ 34,330.41

Hazardous Materials: None.

Maintenance:

- 1. E 306 had transmission leak. Sent to Kelly's Transmission in Huachuca City for repair. Total cost for repair was \$796.79.
- 2. Roof repairs on station should be completed within two weeks. Estimated cost of repairs is \$1,000 to \$1,500.

Communication:

- 1. We will be conducting controlled burns on March 1 in the Cochise Stronghold with the Forest Service and another on March 4th on Rock Creek Rd off Hwy 181.
- 2. We have acquired 4 smart phones for the Captains and myself. The monthly bill from Verizon was raised by \$100.

- 3. We have filled the vacant full time EMT position with Andres Escojido. Firefighter Escojido was a reserve with our District prior to accepting the full time position.
- 4. The fire hydrant committee: Clear Springs will be replacing approximately 10 fire hydrants in our area soon per their employees.
- Grants: Arizona Community Foundation awning grant, awning has been delivered, construction to follow.
 Volunteer Fire Assistance grant: Grant documents have been signed and items are being procured.
- 6. Ambulance: We have completed and delivered the USDA application. We look forward to working with Mr. Hooper.
- 7. Hazardous Properties: We are in the process of scheduling the mitigation of the fire hazard at the Golf Course.
- 8. Local Emergency Planning Committee report, The LEPC's last meeting was February 17, 2017. Again, the LEPC is seeking Tier II reporting facilities within Cochise County to complete site visits and pre-plans. The next is April 21, 2017.
