## Fire Chief's Report for June 18, 2024

## **Training:**

- 1. Monthly EMS training completed.
- 2. Monthly fire training tomorrow will review our new radios issued to us from Cochise County and Swift Water Rescue awareness.
- 3. Completed CPR/First Aid class at the station for community members.

## Wildland:

- 1. We have had multiple initial and extended attack assignments. This month we were able to send 3 apparatus to 3 separate incidents on the same day and still maintain adequate station coverage. Thank you to the employees for their hard work and dedication!
- 2. We have exceeded our expected wildland revenue (\$275,000) for FY23-24. As of today, we have billed out over \$322,000

#### **Out of District Services:**

1. Meeting with the County Assessor on June 28<sup>th</sup>, to move forward with the Dragoon annexation. This will likely be an agenda item next meeting to approve the impact statement.

## **Hazardous Materials and Technical Rescue:**

1. Goodyear Fire Department has donated multiple sets of Swiftwater rescue gear to Cochise County and SPFD has received 5 sets. Thank you, Goodyear Fire!

## **Maintenance**

1. Vehicle and equipment maintenance continues. No vehicles are currently out of service.

## **Communications:**

- 1. AFDA Registration is open for the July conference in Glendale and the January conference in Laughlin.
- 2. Our fiscal year ends on June 30<sup>th</sup>. We are projected to end the year without the need of a registered warrant, and positive balances in both the payroll and reserve accounts.
- 3. After meeting with the Mescal-J6 Fire District last week to offer assistance with their Fire Chief vacancy, I currently recommend against a formal IGA.
- 4. Benson Walmart donated a pallet of bottled water to the district. Thank you, Walmart!

### **Staffing**

- 1. All full-time positions are currently filled.
- 2. Most part-time and volunteer employees have been engaged with training and staffing. We have a new employee on orientation and additional applicants in the hiring process.
- 3. I have increased daytime staffing for fire season until monsoon season arrives and fire danger decreases.
