### Fire Chief's Report for December 17th, 2024

### **Call Volume as of November 30th:**

### **Training:**

- 1. EMS training completed on airway management with AirEvac hosting an airway lab.
- 2. Fire training tomorrow on new SCBA packs and rescuing downed firefighters.
- 3. On duty training continues at the shift level on various topics.
- 4. Two employees are registered for the Arizona Wildfire Fire and Incident Management Academy in Prescott in March.
- 5. Registration is open for the winter ADFA conference in Laughlin. Newly appointed, elected, or re-elected officials have mandatory training that will be offered at the conference.
- 6. We have had several volunteers and part-time employees complete EMT or Fire Academy this semester. This will help boost staffing capabilities heading into the new year.

### Wildland:

- 1. Equipment grant from DFFM opens soon. Intent is to apply for a Type 3 engine. Grant covers up to \$400,000 with any remainder being the responsibility of the District. Proposal will be presented at the January meeting prior to submission since matching funds will be required.
- 2. SPFD with DFFM and Willcox Fire completed an S-131 advanced wildland firefighter course in Willcox December 9-10.
- 3. We are working in conjunction with USFS, BLM, DFFM, and other Fire Districts within the county to create a structure triage preplan within Cochise County. This will help us effectively order and deploy resources when wildland fires threaten residential areas.

### **Out of District Services:**

1. Dragoon annexation progress continues, have received feedback on mapping changes. Board action to adopt official impact statement is anticipated for January or February board meeting.

### **Emergency Medical Services:**

1. AZDHS has approved our general rate adjustment.

### **Hazardous Materials and Technical Rescue:**

1. Applied for equipment on the SHSGP grant. Grant has no matching fund requirements.

### **Maintenance**

- 1. Researching hiring a part-time mechanic vs contracting with another fire agency for shared mechanic services.
- 2. Station and vehicle maintenance continues.

### **Communications:**

1. Awarded \$153,063.64 from the Ak-Chin Indian community. This grant is on the agenda tonight to accept with amended proposal.

### **Staffing**

- 1. We currently have a Full-Time Paramedic vacancy that we are actively trying to fill. We have one candidate who will likely fill the position pending results of a background check and successful completion of orientation
- 2. Most part-time and volunteer employees have been engaged with training and staffing.
